In transference and counter transference, the child's inner objects appear in the therapeutic space as well as the actual parents themselves. The child contains the inner world of the parents. Changes of the child or adolescent often give rise to dramatic acting out in the family. During this process, the parents are challenged to reintegrate their own projections which our patient is ejecting. The focus of this conference will be working on unconscious processes in different settings.
